ORSCNA RDA Report  
October 4, 2001

Hi Family,

I'm grateful to be with you again, Michael and Robin will go into detail about the World Services meeting in Vienna and I'll report on the August MZF and Metro Services workshop in Detroit.

The Detroit Metro Services workshop was held on Saturday, I went to the workshop hoping or maybe expecting to get some ESH for our region, At the last regional meeting there were questions and concerns regarding large metro areas and conventions that we didn't have the experience to answer. However, the metro services workshop didn't answer those questions. I thought, as did the other zonal participants, that Detroit was uttering a workshop to share their ESH regarding metro issues with other regions. Instead, Detroit was holding a workshop to GET ESH from other regions in the zone. We discussed the ways other regions are using the GTLS to improve their service structure and we discussed ideas to improve the Detroit Regions PI, H&I and line committees. We also discussed area conventions at length. There was agreement that there are problems associated with the proliferation of area conventions but there were not a lot of solutions offered. The issues brought up regarding area conventions are as follows:

Conventions.....

- Can be disunifying
- Take trusted servants away from direct services and our primary purpose
- if the convention committee has \$, they can also have control
- There will have to be a change in philosophical way of thinking before we change
- Clamorous and prestigious not anonymous service, convention committee gets introduced at the convention; get a special table, etc.
- We don't always do a good job of attracting to non-convention service
- Can become an "us and we" type of service

The Ohio Region had a lot to offer the Detroit Region regarding shared services. They split from the Michigan Region a few years ago and have not had shared services. After the workshop several of those from both regions said they were interested in finding out from us how we've done shared services. They hope to be in touch with someone from our shared service committee and asked me to see if someone from that committee would give them a call. (!,r)

The MZF was held on Sunday, we began at 9 am with a recovery meeting. The MZF followed the recovery meeting. Most of the day was devoted to discussing the upcoming Worldwide Workshop, which will be hosted by the MZF We are very excited about hosting the workshop, this will be the only worldwide workshop held in the US this year. There was one ww workshop held so far, it was held in Vancouver and was considered a success. There was another ww workshop scheduled for September 14 in London, England and due to current events it was cancelled. The next ww workshop is scheduled November 2-4 in Wellington, New Zealand and then ours will be held in the beginning of February. The workshop will definitely be held in Chicago in February, the date Feb. 1 through 3 is still tentative, and the hotel is still not decided. We thought it would be

held at the Chicago downtown Hilton but the WSO is working on getting a better location. It should be posted on na.org soon, and tlyers should be coming out.

The ww workshop cities, dates, and hotels are organized by world services. The MZF will provide topic ideas, programming and local support people. The workshop, although held in Chicago, is to be focused on issues relevant to our whole zone. The workshop will be recovery oriented, with some service-related topics. There will be no registration fee, but world services asks that we register for planning purposes. The workshop is not at all like a World Services Conference or World Services meeting, it is not about the regional delegates and CAR motions. The purpose of the workshop is communication at a grassroots level with world services about issues relevant to the mid-west. World Services is hoping to attract members from all levels; addicts who are currently involved with service work, addicts who have never done service, addicts who have been involved in service in the past, long-time members, newcomers, and member is encouraged to attend. We hope to put a face on world services; world board members will share at recovery meetings as well as the service workshops and will be approachable for any ideas or questions. The format will be similar to the ww workshop that was held in Vancouver. At Vancouver there were small group discussions, choice of different workshops, recovery meetings, historical NA stuff on display, question and answer sessions, I II/PI panel, sponsorship workshop, medication in NA workshop, literature development, etc. Hopefully members of our region will attend.
