Recovery is doing well in the Cincinnati Area. The geographic areas served by the Cincinnati Area include Hamilton, Clermont and Butler County in Ohio. It also includes Kenton, Campbell and Boone Counties in Northern Kentucky. Our area presently has 68 groups represented with multiple meetings throughout each day. Thirteen groups currently do not have voting privileges. One new group has been started since the January ORSCNA Meeting.

I'm sad to report to the region that this will be my last meeting as the RCM for the Cincinnati Area. I've been doing this for 2 years and have enjoyed my experience very much. However, in the interest of rotation it is time for me to step aside and allow someone else to enjoy this experience. Who knows, maybe I'll run for a position with the Region. You may not be able to get rid of me that quickly.

Our ending balance as of the February ASC meeting was \$8,714.66. Donations for the months of January and February totaled \$1,631.04. Cash expenses over the same period totaled \$4,448.20. I did not get the March data prior to the meeting. I can tell you that the area did make donations to the region and world after the last ASC meeting.

Literature purchases did get our total inventory on hand to the \$5,000.00 prudent reserve amount required by our area. Literature sales for January and February ASC meetings totaled \$3,388.80.

Our area's convention which was held in November of last year presented the area with a check for \$3,905.00 at the January ASC meeting. In addition, our Friends of Jimmy K committee presented our area with a check for \$1,377.86 at the February meeting. Both events were a huge success. The Abnormal Weenie Jam fundraiser will be held April 18, 2015 at the St. James Episcopal Church. The dates for the Abnormal Weenie Jam will be July 31, August 1 and 2, 2015. This is always a great event and we hope to see many of you at this year's event.

I'm happy to report that Darlene M is our new RCMA. Also, Darlene will be running for the position for the following year. In addition, our area will be excepting nominations at the April ASC meeting for Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Treasurer, Vice Treasurer, Literature Distribution, Public Information and Literature Review.

Hello Family!!! KORASCNA serves the geographical areas of Scioto, Lawrence, Pike, and Jackson Counties in Ohio and Greenup, Boyd, Lewis, Carter, and Mason Counties in Kentucky. We currently have 24 meetings per week in our area hosted by 17 home groups. Since our last regional meeting we've lost 2 home groups due to lack of participation, but gained one. We currently average 12 GSR's from the 17 home groups represented. Participation in all sub-committees is growing with involvement from both newcomers and members that's been around. The bank account has been set up for area and all finances seem to be in order. We have a \$66.00 donation to region.

We currently go into 3 facilities with our H&I. Our women go into the Scioto County jail, both men and women go into STAR Correctional Center, and both go into the Lewis County Jail. In the Lewis County Jail State Inmates have yet to attend the meetings, but the message is being carried there for when they want it. H&I is also planning a fellowship day for the summer that will have a workshop and raise money for literature for these facilities.

Fellowship Development in KORASCNA is growing as well, we've recently elected a Vice-Chair for that committee and are putting together Institutional Panels for facilities to help educate on what NA is and isn't. We are currently doing a Critical Mass to set up structure at a meeting in Grayson, KY, and developed Task Force teams to visit meetings that have been showing up to area and encourage their involvement.

On February 28, 2015 KORASCNA hosted a Recovery Prom, as a fundraiser for OCNA, and are pleased to report a donation of \$261.69 given to that committee. We have flyers available for KORASCNA's next events the Spring Laua on May 30 and Friendly Valley on Sept. 19, 20, 21st. We also have tshirts for Friendly Valley and encourage everyone to attend.

Innovations and Challenges

We are currently holding an ADHOC policy meeting every Sunday at 4pm to revise our area policy and to return to a structure of groups telling area what it wants. We will continue this meeting until we are done in which time we plan to hold a review day to have any members and GSR's view the policy and approve or deny, hoping to speed up the process.

We are also having trouble filling our commitments for the womens jail, and have talked of ways to resolve this issue. We had funds stolen from our literature fund and a meeting in our area, a small amount of gossip started, but I believe this has been resolved and the addict committed to paying back the funds.

Our area voted yes to host OCNA 34 and are looking forward with hope and apprehension of the work that is involved in the process. I personally believe that it will be a big benefit to our small area, and people will get to see how big NA truly is.

I'm truly grateful to have been nominated by the LCASCNA area. Hopefully, if all went well earlier, all of you suckers (I mean trusted servants) decided in favor of my nomination. I had to bump up the bandwidth for dascna.org from 6.99 to 7.30 GB so their site could make it through the month. HostGator said it could be from the size of pictures. I ran a statistics report and found certain IP addresses striving to browse the site within the content management system (Joomla). It appeared they could have been trying to hack into the server. I blocked a few IP addresses from overseas (Russia and Ukraine).

Cincinnati had their site go down from a hacker who apparently broke through certain files. HostGator thought that it would be best to change all passwords on a more regular basis. We had to change the point of contact as suggested to an email address not associated with our sites.

BMLT – Steve H. from DASCNA and I have been working on a meeting search server for naohio.org so visitors can search with the click of a mouse or finger to find meetings in the Ohio region. We have made a presentation to give areas, groups and other people an understanding of how simple the process of updating meetings can be versus the way it is currently. I will have to be reimbursed for payment to HostGator for the next three months per policy. To find more information on your own time visit bmlt.magshare.net.

January 10, 2015

Hello Family,

I'll give you the good news first. Things are going pretty well for the current Convention Committee working on OCNA 33 in Cleveland. Since our meeting last quarter I have continued to receive regular e-mails from members of the Committee and have spoken to the Chair and Vice-Chair several times. They have managed to overcome beginning the planning cycle with less than \$500 in start-up funds. Through a lot of hard work this last six months, the OCNA Committee has reached a healthy financial position. Based on the latest information I've received they have approximately \$8,000 (give or take). There is no gravy here because they still have a lot of things to do that will cost money and the host hotel requires payment in full prior to Memorial Day Weekend. Money from Area fundraisers in our Region is still very important for the Convention Committee. So, I encourage everyone to continue the good work you're doing with OCNA fundraising events and if your Area does not have one each year please make a donation to the Ohio Convention Committee in an amount your Area can afford. I do have some ideas and would like us to discuss our options later in old business since it is a pressing issue and we won't be confirming the Convention Chairperson who was nominated in October.

Finally, I am anxious to see how today's vote goes regarding the distribution of revenue from the Ohio Convention. I have been told that this motion has reached the Buckeye Regional Service Committee and action is also being taken up there to resurrect their OCNA Advisory Committee or form a new one which may be called "Shared Services". That's all for now. Thanks for allowing me to serve and for helping me stay clean.
